



State Affiliate Superintendent and Administrator of the Year Nominations

CRITERIA

Criteria established by ALAS requires that the individual nominee be a practicing superintendent or administrator with at least two (2) years experience as a superintendent or administrator, who plans to continue as a practicing superintendent or administrator. The superintendent or administrator must demonstrate evidence of outstanding contributions to the community and to the education profession and must:

- *be a dues-paying member of ALAS or State Affiliate at the time of the award;*
- *be clearly committed to excellence;*
- *have programs designed to meet the academic and social needs of all students, with an emphasis on Latino students; and*
- *have firm ties to parents and the community.*

PLEASE NOTE

Anyone currently holding a position on the ALAS Board of Directors, including its officers, during the official nomination time period is ineligible for selection. Superintendent nominees must be Latino or employed in a HSSD. Administrator nominees must be Latino or employed in a HSSD. A HSSD is K-12 school district whose total student enrollment is at least twenty-five percent (25%) Hispanic. STATE AFFILIATE NOMINATIONS Affiliates may submit up to four (4) nominees from their state in the following four (4) categories:

- Latino Superintendent*
- HSSD Superintendent*
- Latino Administrator*
- HSSD Administrator*
