Prince William County Public Schools (PWCS) is the second largest School Division in Virginia. The Division serves more than 90,000 students in 100 schools and learning centers. PWCS is the 34th largest school district in the nation, encompassing a wide-ranging demographic foundation.

PWCS has over 89,000 students and over 12,000 employees—including over 6,500 dedicated teachers. Students and parents speak more than 144 languages and represent 121 countries. Recently, Forbes ranked Prince William County Public Schools as 11th in Virginia in its ranking of America's best employers and the highest for a school division.
